
## **TRON**






Gold Book Tower Sculpture




## ZACHARY EASTWOOD-BLOOM SCULPTOR | MULTI-MEDIA






# BILLY BURZY PAINTER







## TURNING WINE INTO WORKS OF ART

"In 2013, I began painting with wines. The range of colour in the spectrum of wine is quite amazing but the problem is oxidation. What was once a vibrantly coloured painting can quickly turn to something unattractive, muted and brown. It was through this process that I came up with the concept of preserving wine within sculpture.


I started to experiment with hermetically sealing wines under a vacuum in borosilicate glass vessels and protecting them from UV light with museum grade plexi. This experimentation led to my first collection of wine sculptures titled "Time, suspended", in 2014. My second collection, titled "P a u i II a c" was inspired by the three first growths of the Pauillac region from the 1855 classification of Bordeaux. These sculptures were aesthetic distillations of the experience of the wines and their chateaux. Since then my collections have continued to evolve with various materials and different inspirations. The one common element throughout all of my work is my intention to elevate wine and hold it in reverence."





Donovan Davis is a Professional contemporary artist with over three decades of experience working in hand-cut and handconstructed collage art. Davis deconstructs images to build unexpected artistic configurations and surreal compositions.

Davis' images are both plural and ambiguous. The resulting effect is the creation of an intensely imaginative realm where consciousness gives way to the subconscious. The viewer is led down a path of self-discovery slowing becoming aware that what they see is actually HOW they see it.

Davis' work is untitled as a commentary against labeling, compartmentalization and classification with the intention to allow the at to speak for itself.

Davis has two books published, both are included in the National Library of Canada and Archives Canada collections.

Davis' works can be found in many private collections and global luxury hospitality establishments all around the world including The Londoner, The Bisha and The Hazelton.



#### QUINN HOPKINS

PAINTER, MURALIST, DIGITAL, A/R

Quinn Hopkins is an emerging artist of mixed background with an Indigenous mother and a father of settler heritage. Hopkins began creating art when an Anishinaabe educator and artist, Conrad Bobiwash, taught him to draw in the woodland style.

Hopkins work is inspired by new and innovative technologies and the exploration of connecting them with the land and his Anishinaabe roots. His artworks showcase techniques such as 3D modelling, digital drawing, editing, creative coding and machine learning as he collaborates with the computer to research, design and create. His practice is focused on experimenting with new tools and mediums that allow him to create in the realms of augmented reality, virtual reality, and non-fungible tokens (NFTs).

Hopkins' swiftly emerging artistic career has garnered national and local media attention including CBC's The National, Breakfast Television and CBC Indigenous. His recent large scale works commissioned by The Hart House (The University of Toronto) has brought hm new commissions for digital works.



### ISAAC MURDOCH

PAINTER | MURALIST | DIGITAL ARTIST | SPEAKER

Isaac Murdoch, whose Ojibway name is Manzinapkinegego'anaabe / Bombgiizhik is from the fish clan and is from Serpent River First Nation. Murdoch is well respected as a storyteller and traditional knowledge holder. His works include traditional Ojibway imagery and symbolism, and are influenced by his expertise in harvesting, medicine walks, cultural camps, Anishinaabe oral history, birch bark canoe making, birch bark scrolls, and Youth & Elders workshops.

Murdoch's images, like his stories, reflect his deeply held beliefs in the great spirit of the Earth and engage with the traditional knowledge taught by his Elders: "I am an artist, an activist, an advocate for our people, and a defender of the lands and waters... I believe it is no longer enough to just say something. I believe in the great power of art in bringing positive change. My artistic goal is to be a catalyst in building bridges and communities".



# JOEL RICHARDSON PAINTER | SCULPTOR | FILMAKER

Joel Richardson is a contemporary artist whose work spans over twenty years. His extensive body of art includes large-scale instillation, performance, reworkings of digital technology, video projections, portrait and mural painting.

Richardson became widely known for his 150 meter long mural of An Equation of Suitman that was commissioned by the City of Toronto. His major projects include a large scale multi-faceted interactive exhibition developed in collaboration with the Tom Thomson Gallery, as well as the establishment of an experimental cultural portal and media lab built in a mud hut in Central Kenya called the Metipso Portal.

Richardson is a member of the Director's Guild of Canada and the Toronto-based art collective, *The Time Travel Collective*.

The Travellers is a built upon the relationship between two seemingly conflicting characters travelling together in the same direction. The juxtaposition of the travelers themselves (their roles, time periods, costumes, varying physical appearances in the same environment); a canoe that is made for water going into space; the conflicting time periods where they should belong; etc. gives the viewer a lot to ponder. The artwork asks us to question the relationships, direction, purpose, time and storytelling - all in one compelling body of work.

By melding ancient traditions with modern technologies, The Travellers seeks to explore a new dynamic and encourage a new dialogue. It invokes the question:

where we can go if both have a place in the discussion as opposed to one taking priority or seeking to eliminate the other.


# "The Handmaid's Tale" (Season 2)

Toronto Ontario (2018)

The Handmaid's Tale is an American dystopian tragedy web television series created by Bruce Miller, based on the 1985 novel of the same name by Canadian author Margaret Atwood. The plot features a dystopia following a Second American Civil War wherein a totalitarian society subjects fertile women, called "Handmaids", into child-bearing slavery.

This mural was painted for the American enclave in Toronto of expats in the show. It was later incorporated into my Catskill barn mural (next page).












Untitled, 2016 - stoneware, plywood and paint, 16 x 13 x 16"
